The Adrian and Margaret Harmon Scholarship for MSN in Nursing Education

Maximum award \$20,000

The Adrian and Margaret Harmon Scholarship for MSN in Nursing Education provides up to \$20,000 for a period not to exceed five years. The scholarship recipient is required to commit to two years of employment as a faculty member at one of the 17 member schools of the Greater Kansas City Collegiate Nurse Educators following completion of their MSN in nursing education. The Research Foundation Scholarship for Students in Master's of Nursing Education Programs

Eligible students must hold a BSN and meet admission requirements for graduate study in a nationally accredited nursing program. Funding opportunities include a \$2500 scholarship for a period not to exceed five years for a total of \$5000. For each \$2500 utilized, the individual is required to commit to one year of employment as a nurse faculty member in the Greater Kansas City community following completion of the MSN in Nursing.
